



## ***Selecting Your Group***

For most mentors, recruiting mentees will be the biggest job you have. Young women are so busy with their work, families, friends, houses, churches, and hobbies that engaging their interest in a mentoring group can be challenging—but it holds immeasurable value.

Keep the Vision in mind as you select your group: ***for a spiritually mature woman to walk alongside a younger woman in order to encourage and equip her to fulfill God's purposes for her life and for His glory.***

You're going to have to identify people to invite to apply for your Titus2 Mentoring Group. This will most likely be the most time-consuming part of your whole mentoring season.

Go through your own contacts you know or ask your friends if they can think of anyone. Here are a few ideas on ***where to look***:

- Women whom you've informally mentored over the years
- Wives of younger men that your husband knows
- Women who have moved into the area, started attending your church, but aren't yet connected
- Women whom you may have taught in Sunday school in years past
- Your daughter's or son's friends, or your daughters-in-law
- Younger women in the church that you've met at church events and activities
- Younger women with whom you've been on mission trips
- Women that you have encountered at work or other organizations
- Women who live in your current or previous neighborhood
- Women with whom you've played tennis or other sports

Pray. Ask God to call to mind women that He wants to have this opportunity. This should help you identify ***who you're looking for***:

- Women who are at least one or two seasons of life behind you
- Women who may not have sufficient godly leadership in their life
- Women who are hungry to grow in their relationship with Christ

- Women who need a Godly role model in being a wife, mom, or single woman living out God's purposes in her life
- Women who desire to be challenged in spiritual disciplines
